



Policy: Haulout/Launch Schedule

Haulout Schedule

- We will do our best to haul your vessel at the approximate time discussed when you scheduled however, we ask for your understanding that this schedule is subject to change.
- For us to be the most efficient and deliver you the best value, we need our schedule to be flexible so that it may coincide with other timing issues within the facility. Our schedule is also influenced by things out of our control such as the schedules of other customers and projects going on in the yard

Seeing the bottom of your boat

- If you wish to be present as your vessel is being hauled out of the water, the best time to schedule this is for the first haul of the day, which is around 8am. This minimizes the potential of a change in the hauling schedule.
- For our Project Managers to assess the condition of the bottom of the vessel, this must take place after it has been hauled, washed and set on the hard.
- If possible, leaving your vessel at the docks near the haulout slip and returning later that day, or the following day, to review the project with your manager will streamline the process and save you time.

Cancelation

- Please give KKMI 48 hours notice if you are going to cancel your haulout.
- The haulout schedule is how we determine our crew's schedule. We ask for your consideration of the fact that even small changes can affect the operation of the yard and the timelines for all projects.
- We understand that sometimes occasions arise when you will not know in advance of cancelation or delay, but ask that you alert us of your schedule changes as soon as you can.

KKMI Slips

- KKMI has a limited number of berths for customer's use, before and after their time in the yard. We ask for your cooperation in picking up your vessel as soon as you can after it is launched.
